Are you ready for digital TV? A community announcement

On 25 June 2013 analog TV will be permanently switched off across Regional and Remote Western Australia and free-to-air TV will be broadcast in digital-only.

To continue watching free-to-air TV, households will need to ensure their TVs can receive the digital services. Households can choose to connect a set-top box or digital recorder to an analog TV or upgrade to a digital TV with a built-in digital tuner. Practical and financial assistance is available to help people get ready for digital-only free-to-air TV. The Household Assistance Scheme and the Satellite Subsidy Scheme both allow eligible people across the switchover region to have digital ready equipment installed in their homes. The Household Assistance Scheme also provides in-home aftercare support for 12 months. Households unable to receive adequate terrestrial digital TV reception from terrestrial transmitters can apply to access the Viewer Access Satellite Television (VAST) service.
